Numbers for Fall 2015 Admission

- Applicants: 565

BARUCH MFE APPLICATION PROCESS

No Target Number

The Baruch MFE Program does not have a target number for enrolled students. No application is denied because of a lack of seats in the program, and no applicant is accepted to the program to fill a quota.

Evaluation

There will be four rounds of admissions for the Fall 2016 semester, with the following dates:

Round 1: November 15, 2015

Round 2: January 15, 2016

Round 3: February 15, 2016

Round 4: April 1, 2016

- All applications that are complete by one of the dates above will be evaluated at that time at least by two faculty members.
- Within approximately three weeks of the deadline for each round, interview invitations will be extended. Admission offers will typically be extended prior to the following application deadline.

Prerequisites

- Calculus (two semesters)
- Probability (one semester)
- Linear Algebra (one semester)
- C++ (one semester or certificate)
- Finance (one semester, or relevant work experience)
- Only courses passed with a grade of B or better qualify as prerequisites.



BARUCH MFE APPLICATION PROCESS

Consistency

- The same admission standard for part-time and full-time applicants, as well as for US-based and for international applicants.
- All applicants must have a baccalaureate degree from an accredited four-year college in the United States or its equivalent in another country.

Interviews

- Two interview rounds (in-person or over the phone) are part of the admission process before an admission offer to the Baruch MFE Program is made.
- The interviews are primarily technical, and include mathematical, finance, and C++ programming questions.

Test Scores

- Every applicant must take either the General Test of the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or the Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT).
- The scores must be sent directly to Baruch College using the code 2012.
- TOEFL scores are not required. The ability to communicate in English is assessed at the time of the admission interviews.

BARUCH MFE "FAMILY" AND ALUMNI NETWORK FURTHER STRENGTHEN THE PROGRAM

The Baruch MFE Alumni Association – the only organization of its kind in New York area

- Created in October 2006, over 50% of all our alumni at that time participated, including alumni coming from London and Chicago
- Bi-annual alumni reunions organized by the Alumni Association, high attendance by alumni and
- The Alumni Seminar Series was launched in Fall 2007
- Over 100 people participated to the Baruch MFE Town Hall Meeting in March 2009

Salih Neftci Memorial Scholarship

 Over 105 of 190 all-time Baruch MFE alumni and students donated \$30,000 to endow in perpetuity a scholarship honoring the memory of Salih Neftci, a foremost financial engineering professor and former instructor in the Baruch MFE Program

Baruch MFE C++ Programming for Financial Engineering Online Certificate

- Began in 2012; completed by over 500 students so far from over 20 countries
- Content by Dr. Daniel Duffy; offered through QuantNet
- Each student is assigned an individual teaching assistant (usually Baruch MFE alum)
- 35% of current Baruch MFE students completed the C++ certificate
- 20% of the people completing the certificate in 2015 located in China
- Over 60% of all the people completing the certificate are Chinese
