**Jing Cai**

**Speech Title:**  
**Market Access and Private Sector Development**

---

Jing Cai is the John R. and Marjorie C. Moore Professor of Agricultural and Resource Economics at the University of Maryland. She received her PhD from the University of California at Berkeley in 2012. Her research areas are development economics and household finance, with a focus on how financial and organizational innovations can improve welfare and productivity in developing countries. She is a board member and co-chair of the firm sector of the Abdul Latif Jameel Poverty Action Lab (J-PAL), a Research Associate at the National Bureau of Economic Research (NBER), a fellow of the Bureau for Research and Economic Analysis of Development (BREAD), and a research affiliate of the International Growth Center (IGC). She currently serves as Co-Editor of the Journal of Development Economics and is on the Board of Editors of the American Economic Journal: Applied Economics.

**John Giles**

**Speech Title:**  
**The Role of Research in Development Projects and Policy**

---

John Giles is Lead Economist in the Development Research Group (People Research Program). His current research interests include: the movement of labor from agricultural to non-agricultural employment, internal migration and its impacts on households and communities, poverty traps, household risk-coping and risk-management behavior, long-term effects of shocks to employment, school-to-work transitions, population aging and retirement decisions in developing countries, and women's labor supply decisions in developing countries. He received his Ph.D. in Economics from the University of California at Berkeley in 1999. Prior to joining the World Bank in May 2007, he spent two years as an Academy Scholar at Harvard University's Weatherhead Center for International Affairs, and six years at Michigan State, where he was an Associate Professor before joining the World Bank.

Morten Ravn is a Professor of Economics at UCL. He is a Fellow of Econometric Society, a Fellow of the European Economic Association, and an Advanced ERC Grantee. He has also served as Co-Editor of the Econometric Society journal Quantitative Economics, as Managing Editor of the Economic Journal and as the Chairman of the Publications Committee of the Royal Economic Society. He holds a cand. oecon (MSc in Economics) degree from the University of Aarhus and a PhD degree from the University of Southampton. Prior to joining UCL, Morten has held positions at the University of Southampton, European University Institute, London Business School Universitat Pompeu Fabra and at the University of Aarhus (1994-1995). His research has been published in journals such as the American Economic Review, Econometrica, the Quarterly Journal of Economics, the Review of Economic Studies, Journal of Monetary Economics, Review of Economics and Statistics, and many others. He has been the supervisor of more than 40 PhD students.

**Alberto Salvo**

Alberto Salvo is an environmental economist and behavioural social scientist at the National University of Singapore. He holds a Dean's Chair award in the Department of Economics at the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, is a Principal Investigator at the Lloyd's Register Foundation Institute for the Public Understanding of Risk, and the Lead Principal Investigator in the Social Sciences at the Bezos Centre for Sustainable Protein. Salvo also serves on the University Sustainability and Climate Action Council. Beyond NUS, he is co-editor of the Journal of the Association of Environmental and Resource Economists and a member of the editorial council at the Journal of Environmental Economics and Management. Salvo studies how the behavior and incentives of economic actors, such as households, workers, and firms, interact with scarce environmental resources, such as climate, urban air, land use, food, and water. Ongoing projects relate to the public's awareness of the climate, biodiversity, and plastic crises, personal environmental accountability, and individual action. As an economist, Salvo collaborates across disciplines, including atmospheric sciences, environmental health, consumer psychology, marketing, food science & technology, transport engineering, and strategic communication. His work focuses on Asia's under-studied and globally critical environment and society by partnering with industry, civil society, and government.

Basit Zafar is the Ruebn Kempf Professor of Economics at the University of Michigan and a Research Associate at the NBER. He currently serves as a Managing Editor of the Economic Journal, and the PI of the NLSY97. Professor Zafar is an applied microeconomist whose research focuses on labor economics, the economics of education, and household finance. He has published in leading general-interest journals in economics and finance. While Professor Zafar's research employs a diverse set of empirical methods and techniques, he is primarily a survey researcher.

He received his PhD from Northwestern University in 2008 and his BSc from Caltech. Before joining the faculty at the University of Michigan, he held positions at Arizona State University and the Federal Reserve Bank of New York.

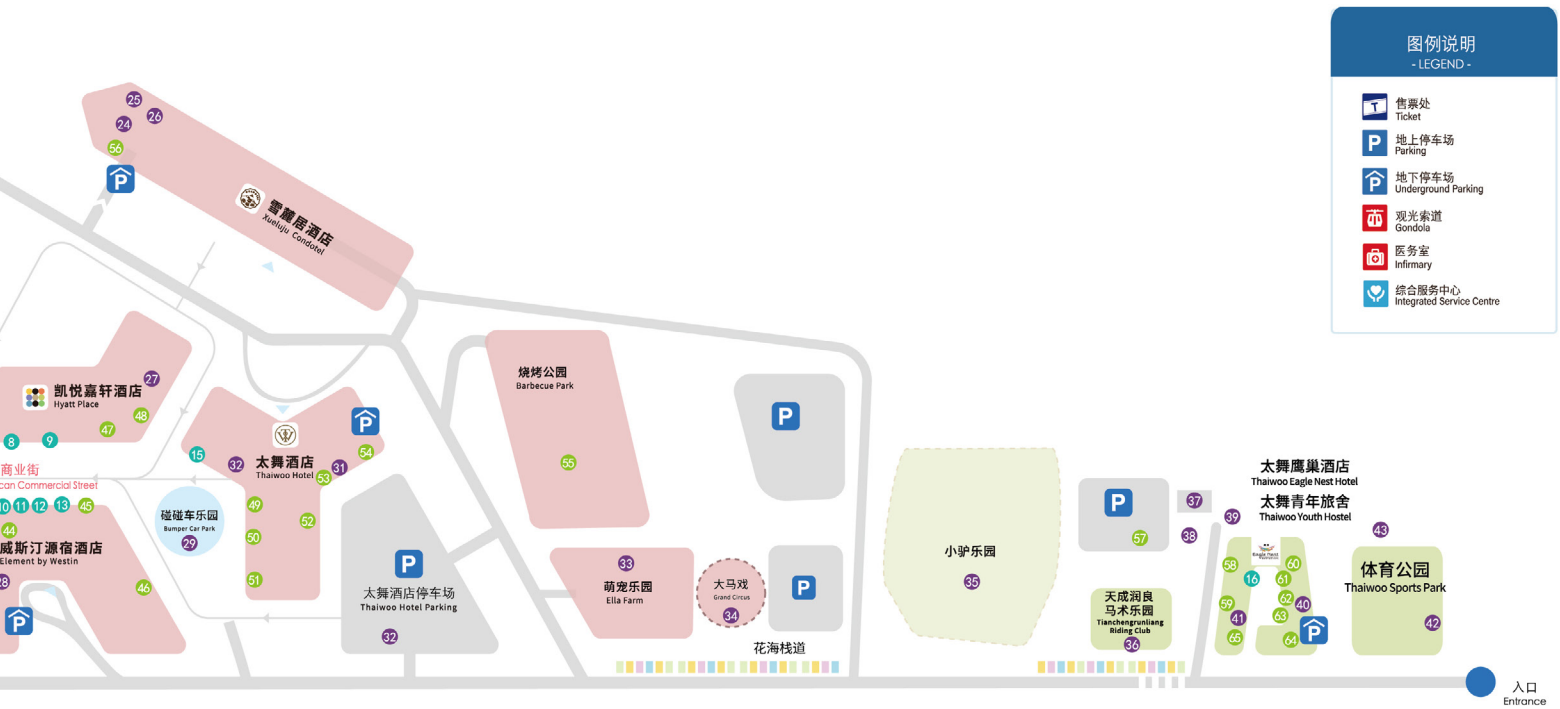
